

SRI Schooling to Combat Child Labor and Early Marriage



GOAL

To reduce child labor for boys and early marriage for girls by providing basic education. This program covers three situations:

- Boys in child labor who have missed elementary schooling
- Girls in religious schools who do not get elementary schooling
- Girls who do not have access to a middle school education due to lack of girls middle schools in their village

PROGRESS TO DATE

120 girls and 40 boys have started attending classes at SRI evening schools

SRI METHODOLOGY

- Boys Elementary Schooling: SRI partners with Pak-Swiss to provide an elementary school education. Eventually we plan to have a middle school for these students, as they are over-age for the government school system
- Girls Elementary Schooling: SRI provides teachers for education resulting in a 5th Grade Certification. After receiving the certification girls go on to government middle schools.
- Girls Middle School: SRI has started a middle school to provide free education to girls in Islampur, Swat

REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE PROGRAM

This is an on-going program and SRI funding depends on continued donations from our supporters

COSTS: Boys Elementary: \$2,400 per yr; Girls Elementary: \$4,500 per yr;
Girls Middle School: \$3,000 per yr
