

SRI PREVENTIVE HEALTH CARE PROGRAM



GOAL

- Reduce infant mortality
- Improve maternal health
- Reduce incidence of major diseases such as Polio, Hepatitis and TB

PROGRESS TO DATE

- Community Health Center established in 2010
- Covers nine villages with a population of 18,000
- Compliance for vaccination has increased from 65% to 95%
- Under-five mortality rate reduced to 40 deaths per 1,000 live births
- Maternal mortality ratio reduced to zero deaths per 100,000 live births

SRI METHODOLOGY

- Monitoring pregnant and lactating mothers
- Growth monitoring of children to detect malnutrition
- Referring malnourished and underweight children to doctors
- Vaccinating mothers and children to prevent major diseases
- Conducting Health and Nutrition Seminars to prevent malnutrition
- Health camps and mother/child workshops
