SRI PREVENTIVE HEALTH CARE PROGRAM







GOAL

Reduce infant mortality
Improve maternal health
Reduce incidence of major diseases such as Polio, Hepatitis and TB

PROGRESS TO DATE

Community Health Center established in 2010
Covers nine villages with a population of 18,000
Compliance for vaccination has increased from 65% to 95%
Under-five mortality rate reduced to 40 deaths per 1,000 live births
Maternal mortality ratio reduced to zero deaths per 100,000 live births

SRI METHODOLOGY

Monitoring pregnant and lactating mothers
Growth monitoring of children to detect malnutrition
Referring malnourished and underweight children to doctors
Vaccinating mothers and children to prevent major diseases
Conducting Health and Nutrition Seminars to prevent malnutrition
Health camps and mother/child workshops
